## CURRENT NEWS

### THREE KENTUCKY ARMY NATIONAL GUARD TECHNICIANS ATTEND AST COURSE.

SSG Harold W. Capps, Co D (Det 1) 201st Engr Bn, SSG Ermine S. Fuller Jr., Det 1, Co I 201st Engineer Bn and SSG Roger W. Lambert of 2123d TC Co, Bowling Green, Kentucky are the first KyARNG technicians attending the first class held at Camp Robinson, Arkansas. GARNISHMENT OF WAGES. Public Law 93-647 which became effective 1 January 1975 permits the garnishment of the salary of military members and civilian technicians for child support and alimony payments. Guidelines for implementing this law are being prepared by DoD.
