SUPERVISOR'S CORNER

TECHNICIAN PERFORMANCE RATINGS. Technician Performance Ratings (NGB Forms 2) for those technicians in grades 8 thru 10 are due during the month of August.

INSURANCE. Copies of orders for technicians attending schools/training in excess of 30 days must be furnished the TPO in order that the required administrative changes in the technician's insurance may be accomplished. Failure to do this may result in jeopardizing a technician's benefits.

ANNUAL REVIEW OF ARNG/ANG TECHNICIAN POSITION DESCRIPTIONS. Positions description reviews for the areas listed below are to commence on 1 July, be completed and forwarded to TPO for submission to NGB not later than 15 August.

ARNG: State Headquarters, Training Operations, Technician Personnel.
ANG: Comptroller, Technician Personnel, Military Personnel Administration Command, Medical and Security.

Reviews for the following areas are to begin on 1 August, be completed and forwarded to NGB not later than 15 September:
