FORMER AIR NATIONAL GUARD TECHNICIAN SWORN IN AS NEW DEPUTY ADJUTANT GENERAL FOR ARMY/ ASSISTANT ADJUTANT GENERAL FOR AIR. On 9 March 1978 in the Conference Room of the EOC Building, Frankfort, Kentucky, Judge Pleas Jones of the Kentucky Supreme Court swore in Brigadier General Taylor L. Davidson as Deputy Adjutant General for Army and Assistant Adjutant General for Air. Our congratulations and continued support is extended to General Davidson.

NGAUS INSURANCE CERTIFICATES. Certificates for insurance and Insert A are inclosed for those technicians covered under this program. The NWNL Form 24368 (Blue Stripe) indicates group life insurance coverage and Form 24369 (Yellow Stripe) indicates disability coverage. These certificates, along with Insert A, SHOULD be kept with your permanent personal files and records.

REVISED PAMPHLET - THE FEDERAL EMPLOYEES GROUP LIFE INSURANCE PROGRAM (STANDARD FORM 176A). This pamphlet has been extensively revised to more accurately describe the program. The TPO should be receiving copies in the near future and distribution will be made via mailing of the "Technician Topics". Once you receive the new revised copy, the old copy should be destroyed.

LEAVE WITH PAY PENDING DISABILITY RETIREMENT NTE. If a technician has not lost his/her military membership upon receipt of adjudication of the disability retirement claim, the individual is entitled to continue using whatever sick leave he or she has available until such leave has been exhausted or until loss of military membership, whichever occurs first.

RETIREES - COST OF LIVING INCREASE. Employees who retire on immediate annuities between March 1, 1978 and before September 1, 1978 increase will be guaranteed as much annuity, based on the total service and "high 3" average pay that existed on February 28, 1978 plus the 2.4 percent cost of living increase effective 1 March 1978.

RETIREES WITH FEDERAL EMPLOYEES' GROUP LIFE INSURANCE COVERAGE (FEGLI).

REGULAR INSURANCE. A participant who retires on an immediate annuity after 12 years of creditable service or retires for disability retains this insurance (not accidental death and dismemberment), without further cost to the participant.

OPTIONAL INSURANCE. A participant who retires may retain optional life insurance (not accidental or dismemberment) if eligible to continue regular life insurance and if, in addition, the participant had the optional insurance in force for the full period or periods during which optional insurance was available.

AFTER AGE 65. After one reaches age 65, both regular and optional life insurance are reduced by two percent per month until a total reduction of 75 percent is reached. The remaining balance continues until the retired participant's death.
