**WITHER THE WEATHER?** Today with overcast at 1,000 feet and rain sprinkling down our visibility was cut to 2½ miles. Light ground fog and haze hung low in the area with surface winds of only light and variable direction. Low temperature this morning was 59° and the expected high will be about 64°. Thursday we are looking for clearing off, ceilings lifting to about 2,000 feet with broken cloud cover with light and variable winds from the northeast.

**FLIGHTS CANCELLED:** With the poor weather conditions at hand, all tactical sorties were cancelled for the day. The support aircraft, the C-131, left this morning for Louisville, piloted by Col. William Gast, Col. Eugene Kimmaird and Capt. John Ogden. They planned to go to Louisville and return today by late afternoon.

**RELIGIOUS SERVICES PLANNED:** Chaplain (Lt. Col.) Robert Williams has announced there will be a church service for all faiths at 1 p.m. Thursday, June 12, at the Base Chapel (same as the Theater, Bldg. 502). **REGULAR SERVICES SUNDAY:** General Protestant services will be scheduled at 10 a.m. on Sunday, June 15 at the Base Chapel/Theater, Bldg. 502 conducted by Chaplain Williams. Buses will leave from the Chapel at 10 a.m. for St. James Catholic Church where Mass will be said at 10:30 a.m.
